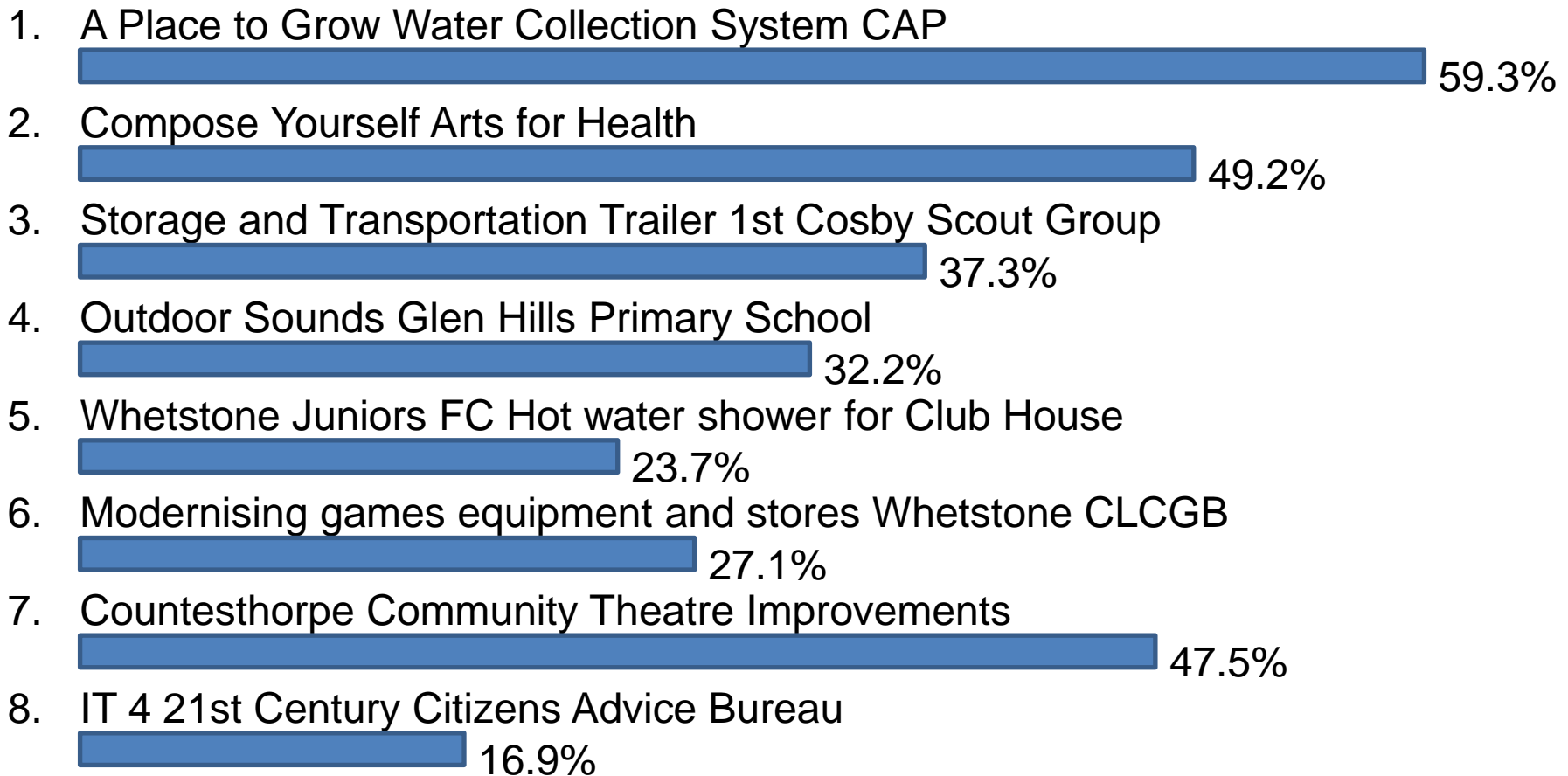
How did the voting work?

- Each Workshop Participant had a 'voting handset'.
- In the first round of voting, participants gave each project a score between 1 and 9. The 8 projects with the highest average score went through to the second round.
- In the second round, participants could each vote for 3 projects.
- They could not vote for the same project more than once – this would automatically invalidate their votes.
